NIPIKA ECOLODGE is nestled in the Canadian Rockies, beside Kootenay National Park, and offers guests year-round recreation and leisure right out the front door of luxurious lodge and cabin accommodations. This trip includes 5 nights at the lodge. We'll have a new adventure each day – hiking to Mitchell Ridge to view Mt. Assiniboine and a day hike to Aurora Creek.

The lodge is on the shore of the Kootenay River. We will spend 2 days exploring the river by canoe – paddling past a natural rock bridge, tufa deposits, and fascinating Hoodoos sculpted by wind and water. The river flows swiftly with class I and II rapids but no experience is needed to paddle our stable SOAR inflatable canoes.
